

Stonehenge a Possible monument to a Giant?

The "*Heelstone*" has been called that since antiquity. It is not merely a standing stone. It appears to be a Giants Foot. A recently noticed fossilization process [1] accounts for this "Body part" being preserved.

1...Look carefully at the architecture and see the obvious look of a foot...toes etc. Touch your own foot and feel the contours, it is the same. Also underground the anatomy is exact....a heel.

2...There is a black stain where the bone and blood supply is broken this is FERATIN from bone marrow. EXACTLY as in observed bone fractures today. The black is Iron Oxide.[2]

3...There is a cut running into the center area from the smaller toe. This is a tendon margin, there is very little decomposition in this foot. Only very soft fleshy areas have deteriorated it appears.

4...There are rust colored spots on the bridge of the foot, These are blood gases and fluids. Caused by cadaverine and putresine in bodily fluids also containing iron. (FE2 and FE3 are both Iron oxides, One is black the other redish)[3]

5...There are other "Stone Circles" in those lands. Is it possible they are "Memorials to Fallen Heros"???

6...With this knowledge of Giants, A new look is needed in all structures and symbols around the world as well as constructions, Nasca lines and many old stories.

7...The chemistry will prove or disprove this and it is quite simple to do. 3 DNA tests and 7 cat scans proved my specimens are human and as big as Stonehenge Giant.[4]

8...We will be looking into the chemistry soon and would like colaborators.

9...I have the physical specimens to test against.[5]

10...I have other sites that have much larger petrified giant creature remnants. A video is in the works. These Giant remnants are Primarily connective tissue as it is very durable.
